### **Competition rules:**

• Based on International Karate Organization Kyokushinkaikan international competition rules

# **Requirements of entry:**

- valid "may compete" sports medical registration
- payment of the entry fee (transferred in advance against the invoice)
- clean karate gi, protective equipment

# Categories – Fighting (based on age on the day of the competition):

- kindergartner: 3-5 year olds (head-ankles)
- children III.: 6-7 year olds
- children II.: 8-9 year olds
- children I.: 10-11 year olds
- adolescent: 12-13 year olds
- youth: 14-15 year olds
- junior: 16-17 year olds
- adult: 18-34 year olds
- senior: 35+ year olds

The weight categories will be determined by the number of competitors entered (by halving or by thirds).

Required protective equipments (We ask everyone to bring their own protective equipment!):

With the exception of the adult age group, knee guards can be used, and mouthguards are recommended in all categories. All protective equipment must be provided by the competitors themselves.

- children and adolescents: 1,5 minutes, in case of a draw, 1,5 minutes extra time •
- youth and junior and adult: •
- 2 minutes, in case of a draw, 2 minutes extra time
- senior:

1,5 minutes, in case of a draw, 1,5 minutes extra time

- **Prizes:** 
  - First place: cup, medal, certificate
  - medal, certificate 2nd to 3rd place:
  - Special prizes for the best spirit male and female competitor

### Entry fee:

- Kata or kumite: €15
- For entries in more than one category: €20
- Team kata: €20/team

### Entrance fee for guests:

- On site: €5/person
- In advance: €3/person (until 08. November 2024.)
- Free for children under 6 years old
- Up to 10 competitors per association have 1 coach and 1 accompanying person free of charge. For more than 10 competitors, the entry of one additional coach is free
- Advance tickets are non-refundable!
